Options include leaving things as they are, fielding a junior varsity team for a couple of years or going to 8man.

Burkowski told the board that Steve Totheroh, Milford High School principal, is willing to attend a board meeting to discuss the 8-man program. Totheroh also serves vice president of the Illinois 8-Man Football Association.

The association started with seven schools in winter 2017 as a way for small schools to continue their football programs. It now stands at 16 members, including Milford-Cissna Park, Schlarman Academy and Judah Christian.

The drawbacks to 8-man are the same as they were in May: will Hoopeston Area be able to fill its schedule and how far will the team have to travel.

Totheroh will be invited to the board's November meeting to discuss the 8-man option. Klaber would like a decision by December so he can notify the conference. A December decision will also allow Burkowski to schedule training for coaches if the board approves moving to 8-man.
