Hoopeston Area High School looks at football options again

For the second time in five months, Hoopeston Area officials are taking a look at high school football options. A three-district team of Hoopeston Area, Armstrong-Potomac and Schlarman Academy was disbanded after Schlarman opted to go to 8-man football in March. At its May meeting, the board weighed going to the 8-man program but decided to stay with 11-man football in the Vermilion Valley Conference. With the Cornjerkers at 0-8 with one game left in the season, the board's curricular/extra-curricular committee, high school Principal John Klaber and athletic director Nate Burkowski discussed options with the board. The district needs to look at the next step, said commit-


tee member Lee Cox, "because what we're doing right now isn't working so good." Options include leaving things as they are, fielding a junior varsity team for a couple of years or going to 8-man. Burkowski told the board that Steve Totheroh, Milford High School principal, is willing to attend a board meeting to discuss the 8-man program. Totheroh also serves vice president of the Illinois 8-Man Football Association. The association started with seven schools in winter 2017 as a way for small schools to continue their football programs. It now stands at 16 members, including Milford-Cissna Park, Schlarman Academy and Judah Christian. The drawbacks to 8-man are the same as they were in May: will Hoopeston Area be able to fill its schedule and how far will the team have to travel. Totheroh will be invited to the board's November meeting to discuss the 8-man option. Klaber would like a decision by December so he can notify the conference. A December decision will also allow Burkowski to schedule training for coaches if the board approves moving to 8-man. This is not the first time Hoopeston Area has faced decisions related to football. In 2012, because of low See FOOTBALL on other side
