Residents to judge Columbus as part of interactive play

Area residents will get to play the Spanish Royal Court in an interactive historical play when Hank Fincken sails into Hoopeston Saturday as Christopher Columbus.

Fincken brings his one-man play, Christopher Columbus: The Shame in the Glory, to the Lorraine at 7 p.m. Saturday.

In his play, Fincken's Columbus tries to explain his goals and deeds from 1492-1506. The audience must decide if the Admiral is a hero or villain.

While Bringing Columbus to the Lorraine, Fincken, "A National Theatre Company of One," has written and performs plays on many other characters, includ-

ing Johnny Appleseed, Henry Ford, Thomas Edison, W.C. Fields and others.

For more than 20 years, Fincken has toured across the globe as a living history performer, bringing audiences in America, Europe and South America into the history he portrays.

Each character has been researched thoroughly. The script for each of his plays took a minimum of two years to write and has been critiqued by scholars and theater professionals.

Tickets are \$8 for adults and \$3 for kids 12 and younger. The performance is sponsored by the Lorraine Foundation and Hoopeston Historical Society.
