Hoopeston City Council not high on local cannabis shops

Recreational cannabis businesses will not be welcomed in Hoopeston.

In a 5-2 vote, Hoopeston City Council approved not allowing cannabis-related businesses in the city. Voting to keep the businesses out were aldermen Alex Houmes, Robin Lawson, Bill Goodwine, Carl Ankenbrand and Lourdine Florek. Voting against barring the businesses were aldermen Jeff Wise and Bill McElhaney. Ald. Chad Yaden was absent.

He said the state's legalization of recreational cannabis is foremost about balancing its budget "because they pass this law giving local municipalities and police departments little to no guidance on how to regulate its use."

Unknowns include what the social cost will be of recreational cannabis use, how law enforcement will be affected, how schools will handle the impact of students under the influence because cannabis is available at home and how quickly employers will be able to develop new policies and ways of monitoring use to prevent unsafe working conditions. the use of cannabis statewide without caring to have these answers...but we should," he added.

Speaking strongly for the other side, Wise said, "The problem is it's going to be legal, they're going to buy it somewhere else, the tax money is going to go somewhere else and they're going to bring it here. In my opinion, it's ridiculous to try to prohibit it just in Hoopeston."

Also, currently Vermilion County is slated to have one recreational cannabis dispensary, expected to be in Danville. If the state allows a second one in the county, "Hoopeston will not be in the running and another town will."

Wise said he wishes the state had not legalized recreational marijuana and is against the use of it, but that if someone "wants to spend that kind of money to bring something like that to Hoopeston, let's get some money off of it."

Houmes said his research showed him recreational cannabis shouldn't be allowed in Hoopeston, while Wise said his research showed it should. "I would love to bring more people in and show what research they've done that show this is a positive thing."

Mayor Bill Crusinberry said he would like to watch what happens for six months to see how the distribution system works. "If the projections are right, with what the

state says, if it stays far below what the state projected, distribution centers will be less," he predicted. "If it's above, I think they'll be pushing to have more distribution centers in the state."

The law bans adult-use cannabis craft growers, cultivation centers, dispensing organizations, infuser organizations or infuser, procession organization or processor and transporting organization or transporter.

He also commented that should the council decision be reversed in the future, Illinois Municipal League recommends creating new zoning ordinances to govern recreational cannabis businesses, similar to ordinances governing alcohol sales.

While not allowing recreational cannabis businesses, the council voted 7-0 to put a tax on cannabis sales in the event that sales are allowed in the future.

The proposed ordinance set the tax at three percent, but Florek asked if it could include "the highest percent allowed by law" at the time a future council might allow sales. With a change made, the ordinance passed 7-0.
