Operations manager talks trash to solve pickup problems

Problems still exist when it comes to garbage in Hoopeston.

On the residents' side, complaints range from garbage not being picked up to calls to Republic Services not being returned.

From Republic Services' side, complaints include residents overloading the blue totes and also putting banned items in the containers.

To help solve the problems, Toby Wolfe, local Repub-

lic Services operations manager, has provided information that hopefully will help both his employees and residents.

Wolfe said it is against the law to put some items in landfills. The list includes corrosive waste, appliances, electronics, empty tanks, flammable waste, fluorescent bulbs, railroad ties, tires, used oil and landscape waste.

Items considered unacceptable for general trash include

barrels, hazardous waste, liquids, medical waste, paint or paint cans, construction debris (pipes, boards, drywall, ceiling tiles, sinks, tubs, shower surrounds, flooring) and septic waste.

While those items should not be put in the weekly trash, they may be taken to the landfill, but some require EPA permitting first. Drywall and general construction materials may be taken to the landfill with no notice. For the rest, residents should call Republic Services, (217) 554-7016, in advance so the company can get a permit.

The cost to residents to dispose of a pickup truck load of materials is \$52 per load, Wolfe said.

As for the blue totes, residents are welcome to fill them to the brim...but no further. Totes filled to the point the lid will not close will not be picked up. Each tote will hold 80-100 lbs., Wolfe said.

Garbage does not need to be bagged to be placed in totes, but Wolfe suggested bagging to keep the totes free from odors and from having liquids deteriorate the plastic of the tote. Bagging would also help eliminate pieces of trash being caught by the wind and ending in neighborhood yards.

Totes should be located within three feet of the road and have at least three feet of obstacle-free clearance around each tote.

Wolfe also suggests residents put their totes out the night before their pickup day. Republic Service employee start times are flexible, based on the weather and other factors, to pickup time can vary. Putting the tote out the night before assures residents’ trash is picked up the day it is scheduled.
