## Flight canceled, Zobrist drives to local autograph session

A former Chicago Cubs player is getting kudos for kindness off the field.

Ben Zobrist, currently a free agent after his contract with the Cubs ended with the 2019 season, was scheduled to appear at Bricks & Ivy Sports for an autograph session Saturday. The plan was for him to fly from Nashville, Tenn. to Chicago, on Friday, then drive roughly 115 miles to Hoopeston.

Weather issues caused his flight to be canceled. Switching to a Nashville-to-Indianapolis, Ind., flight was discussed, but Zobrist was concerned it, too, might be canceled and so would the autograph session.

So the Eureka native, who currently lives in a Nashville suburb, grabbed his brother and sister-in-law and started on the 350-mile drive to Hoopeston. The trio spent Friday night somewhere in Indiana before rolling into Hoopeston Saturday.

At Bricks and Ivy, Zobrist chatted with those who came for his autograph and signed the wall at the store before making a surprise visit to Monical's for a bite to eat.

After the event, Zobrist got a glowing review from Bricks & Ivy owners Bob and Emily Brown, posting on the store's Facebook page, "Not only did he take photos and sign autographs with fans, he had a conversation with each person in line. He interacted with children, held babies, and asked people about themselves and their lives."

Photos of Zobrist at the store and pizza parlor were posted to social media and word of Zobrist's dedication to fans made sports news across the country.

The 38-year-old second baseman/outfielder, played for the Tampa Bay Devil Rays, Oakland Athletics and Kansas City Royals before coming to the Cubs. He has played in three World Series, winning the last two.

Zobrist, nicknamed "Zorilla," has a .266 batting average, has scored 167 home runs and has 768 RBIs to his credit.
