
City hears request to use Schumacher plant for pot plants

A request to use part of the former Schumacher plant as a craft grower under the Illinois' cannabis law got mixed reactions at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Mayor Bill Crusinberry said he was approached by the new owner of the property about using one fourth of the former factory as a growing site.

The property, at 1025 E. Thompson, sold in April 2019 to a Wyoming-formed corporation, Alexander Real Properties LLC, of Bourbonnais. Principals are Nancie and Jerry Alexander.

In November, the council voted, 5-2, to disallow any cannabis business in the city and 7-0 to allow a city tax on cannabis products if sales are allowed in the future.

Although the council could not vote on the request because the item was not on the agenda, discussion broke similar to the November vote.

Crusinberry said the owner thought it would be a longshot and that, if allowed, he would sell his product to a distributor, he didn't want to go to the effort of filling out all the state paperwork if officials would not allow it. "Are we interested in reversing that ordinance and putting that building to use as a craft grower of cannabis," he asked.
