City council to delay new budget to determine effect of COVID-19 on income sources

Hoopeston officials plan to temporarily postpone making a new budget to more effectively gauge the effect of the coronavirus situation.

Aldermen had prepared 2020-21 budgets for their individual departments and turned them in Thursday in preparation for a March 31 budget meeting.

At Friday's emergency council meeting, Ald. Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman, presented a typical budget, with \$2,353,177 in income, \$2,175,250 in expenses and \$176,927 in one-time requests. If all one-time expenses were approved, "which we've never done," he said, Hoopeston would be left with a \$24,974 shortfall.

But, Goodwine believes Hoopeston may not receive as much in sales, income or personal property replacement (PPRT) taxes, due to businesses being shuttered to help stop the spread of the coronavirus.

He presented two other budget scenarios, one with sales tax down 10 percent and income and PPRT down 20 percent, which showed a \$231,874 deficit.

The second, with a 20 percent drop in sales tax and 30 percent less income and PPRT taxes, would leave Hoopeston in the red by \$362,574.

PPRT replaced personal property taxes on corporations, partnerships, and other business entities, which were abolished.

"Nobody's making any money," he said. "If this lasts three, four weeks, five weeks, six weeks, three months, who knows how much income tax? If nobody's making anything, taxes could go down much more than 20%.

Goodwine said the city can run under the appropriation ordinance, which is the budget plus an additional five percent for contingencies. The council will vote on a new appropriations ordinance in July, to take effect August 1.

One-time expenses will be frozen for the time being. "We haven't needed them for 20 years, or 15 years, so what's big the emergency now," he asked. With the shutdown, "nobody's making any money," Goodwine said. "If this lasts for three, four weeks, five weeks, six weeks, three months, who knows how

Waiting a month would give officials a clearer picture, Goodwine said. "If the virus is over, we can say 'well, it's going to be less than budget 2.' If we're still under lockdown practically, we're going to have a lot less income."

Ald. Carl Ankenbrand questioned the impact the virus is having on Hoopeston. "We're still spending money in this town," he said, adding at Hoopeston IGA, "it's nuts," with the store taking in more than \$50,000 one night. While it's weird not seeing cars at local restaurants, Ankenbrand said he still sees people supporting local businesses.

"A lot of local business can't be open," Goodwine said. "

"So you're not concerned about us being in a room together, you're concerned about the economy," Ankenbrand asked Goodwine.

"Yes, because we're talking about budgets," he answered.

Returning to the issue, "I don't want to say 'let's do it all' and find out we don't have the money," Goodwine said. "We can meet Tuesday. I think it would be a waste of time. We'll just bide our time."

For the safety of residents and their employees, Republic Services has implemented changes in the wake of COVID-19.
