Vermilion County holding at five COVID cases, Iroquois at seven

Editor's note: In reporting cases of COVID-19, Just the Facts is using the generic "him," or "his" rather than "he or she" or the plural "their." The person's gender was not released by the Vermilion County Health Department.

No confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Vermilion County this week.

While more tests have been done this week, none were reported positive, said Public Health Administrator Doug Toole Wednesday. A total 257 people have been tested with results that came back negative. Five positive results were announced last week, including a person in his 20s, reported March 31; a second person in his 20s reported

April 1; two people in their 30s, announced April 2 and a person in his 70s, reported April 3.

Vermilion County's neighbor to the north, Iroquois County, has reported seven confirmed cases, including a man in his 20s, a man in his 30s, two men in their 40s, one in his 50s, another in his 70s and a woman in her 60s.

Neither Vermilion County nor Iroquois County officials are releasing where in their respective counties those who test positive reside.

No deaths have been reported from coronavirus in either county.

As of Thursday, only 23 of Illinois' 102 counties had reported counties no confirmed COVID-19 cases.
