Scholarships awarded to two Iroquois County high school seniors

Two Iroquois County young people are among 30 high school students who received scholarships from Farm Credit Illinois.

A total of \$60,000 in scholarships was awarded to seniors throughout central and southern Illinois to pursue agriculture-related majors and careers. Each of the 30 recipients received a \$2,000 agriculture scholarship. The area students are:

- Bailee Fanning, of Milford, who will graduate from Milford High School and attend the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign to study agricultural and consumer economics, public policy and law. She is the daughter of Terry and Jody Fanning.

- Payton Kaeb, of Buckley, who will graduate from Cissna Park High School and attend Parkland College to study precision agriculture. He is the son of Warren and Jill Kaeb.

The scholarship program has awarded \$516,000 to 387 students since 2004. Selections are based on academic achievement, participation and leadership in school and community organizations, and the applicant’s commitment to an agricultural career.

“Farm Credit Illinois scholars represent tomorrow’s agricultural leaders,” said Rod Stoll, FCI vice president of marketplace engagement. “Investing in their education today – on behalf of our cooperative’s members – will help positively shape the future of the industry and Rural America.”
