Social Security Administration offers guidance for retirees, SSI recipients on getting Economic Impact Payments

The Treasury Department launched a new web tool allowing quick registration for Economic Impact Payments (EIP) for eligible individuals who do not normally file a tax return, and also announced that it would begin making automatic payments.

However, for some people receiving benefits from the Social Security Administration - specifically those who have dependent children under the age of 17 - it is to their advantage to go to this portal to ensure they also get the \$500 per dependent EIP. "I encourage them to do this as soon as possible, and want to provide the following details," said Andrew Saul, Social Security commissioner:

People who receive Social Security retirement, survivors, or disability insurance benefits and who did not file a tax return for 2018 or 2019 and who have qualifying children under age 17 should now go to the IRS webpage, www.irs.gov/coronavirus/economic-impact-payments to enter their information instead of waiting for their automatic \$1,200 EIP. By taking proactive steps to enter information on the IRS website about them and their qualifying children, they will also receive the \$500 per dependent child pay-

ment in addition to their \$1,200 individual payment. If Social Security beneficiaries in this group do not provide their information to the IRS soon, they will have to wait to receive their \$500 per qualifying child.

The same guidance applies to SSI recipients, especially those who have qualifying children under age 17. To receive the full amount of the EIP for which they are eligible, recipients should go to the "Non-Filers: Enter Payment Info" page at www.irs.gov/coronavirus/economic-impact-payments and provide information about themselves and qualifying children.

New beneficiaries since January 1, 2020, of either Social Security or SSI benefits, who did not file a tax return for 2018 or 2019, will also need to go to the

Non-Filers website to enter their information.

Lastly, Social Security retirement, survivors, or disability beneficiaries who do not have qualifying children under age 17, do not need to take any action with the IRS. They will automatically receive the \$1,200 EIP directly from the IRS as long as they received an SSA-1099 for 2019.

For SSI recipients who do not have qualifying children under age 17, Social Security continue to work closely with Treasury to make these payments automatically. Please note that we will not consider EIP as income for SSI recipients, and the payments are excluded from resources for 12 months.
