Hoopeston offices closed until June 1 on Pritzker extension

Gov. JB Pritzker's extension of the stay-at-home order through May means Hoopeston offices will be closed until at least June 1.

Hoopeston Emergency Managers Group - made up of EMA Director Brad Hardcastle, Police Chief Jim DeWitt, Fire Chief Joel Bird and Mayor Bill Crusinberry - met earlier this week to review and revise the current response plan, Hardcastle said. The following changes were made:

- City hall remains closed. Payments for water bills and other city service can be made over the phone by calling (217) 283-5833, in the drop box outside city hall or online through the city website, cityofhoopeston.com/

- Water shutoffs will continue to be on hold but balances will accrue late charges on any delinquent accounts..

- The police department window also remains closed. Contact with the department may be made by calling (217) 283-5196 or an intercom is available in front of city hall

- Effective May 1, all non-2020 golf cart stickers will expire. Owners may download the permit application and self-inspection checklist on the city webpage, cityof-hoopeston.com/forms-and-applications/ or call (217) 283-5833 to have the forms mailed to them. Both forms must
