COVID count steady at 19

Vermilion County is steady at 19 confirmed cases of coronavirus. The most recent case, a person in his 60s, was announced Wednesday by Public Heal Administrator Doug Toole. As of Friday, 726 county residents have been tested, 19 confirmed positive, one remains hospitalized and one has died, he said.
