Demolition work begins on former Vermilion Iron buildings, financial partners needed

It looked like a hungry yellow creature had come to the Vermilion Iron site, as an excavator operator used his machine to take a bite of the former Vermilion Iron office, then swung the arm around to dump the debris, before completing the circle to take another chomp.

The same company used to demolish buildings after the 2013 tire fire at the former FMC building is using its expertise to take down foundry buildings. Lee Farms Excavating, of Paxton, began demolition Tuesday at the former plant, at 225 N. Sixth Ave. The property is owned by Hoopeston Land Improvements, Inc., formed in 2018 to deal with the Vermilion Iron property, said Harry Brockus, corporation board member and former Hoopeston Hospital CEO.

After taking on the abandoned property, the corporation had phase 1 and 2 environmental studies done to determine any contaminated areas. Asbestos was found at the site and was removed in January. When that work was finished, board members "got a lot of phone calls saying it looked worse" than before the work started.

Removing the asbestos cost \$180,000, Brockus said. Demolition, which will include Lee Farms Excavating removing all the steel, and then crushing the concrete block, will cost \$125,000.

The crushed block will be given to Hoopeston's street and alley department to use, he said.

The biggest expense of remediating the property will be the most expensive. "Eventually, the landfill has to be addressed." Brockus said.

The Environmental Protection Agency has a process for dealing with old landfills, which will have to be followed, Brockus said. Landfill cleanup is estimated at \$300,000 to \$400,000.

Brockus has said previously that Hoopeston Land Improvements will need partners to complete the remediation. "We haven't had anybody step up and now is not the time to ask for money," he said. He's not asking now, but he has his eye on the future. "We'll work on it into 2021," he said. He hopes the Central Illinois Land Bank started as the Vermilion County Land Bank but expanded to include other areas, most recently Decatur - may be able to help.

Once the site is clean, Hoopeston Lane Improvements' plan is to turn the property over to the city to use as a park.

The foundry, started in 1907, was purchased in 1946 by Deere & Co., and renamed John Deere Malleable Iron Works. It became Vermilion Iron Corp., when it was sold in 1976, then becoming Vermilion Iron Works in 1993.

The plant closed in February 2007, and was purchased by an investor that April. It closed again and, in 2013, was bought at a tax sale, and then sold to Hoopeston Land Improvements on July 6, 2018.

Hoopeston Land Improvements, Inc. was formed in April 2018, separate from, but with the same board members as Hoopeston Retirement Village Foundation.

Hoopeston Land Improvements was involuntarily dissolved in September 2019, but was later reinstated.
