Zip code makes IDPH map for number of COVID-19 cases

In an effort to maintain patient confidentiality while also keeping the public informed about COVID-19, the Illinois Department of Public Heath created a map on which zip codes with more than five confirmed cases are

The zip code 60942, which includes Hoopeston and Cheneyville, made the map last week, with six confirmed

While just now meeting criteria for the map, Public Health Administrator Doug Toole said that doesn't mean there is a sudden outbreak in the area. "I can say that the cases in that zip code have appeared one-by-one, over the past few weeks," he said. "We consider an 'outbreak' to bee two or more lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in a facility or (non-household) group with an onset in a 14day period. There are no COVID-19 outbreaks in Hoopeston at this time."

Due to the nature of the novel coronavirus, health administrators have been granted an exception to HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) health information privacy laws, according to the Office of the Attorney General for the State of Illinois.

Addresses of those confirmed to have the virus are provided to 9-1-1 call centers. The information becomes available to first responders going to the specific address so they may wear appropriate personal protective equipment and reduce the risk of transmission.

Releasing the information "was not a decision we made lightly," Toole said, "We take the protection of our residents' privacy and medical information very seriously. It was only after reading the state's decision, consulting with the Vermilion County State's Attorney, and talking with our own HIPAA expert that we began notifying the county's 9-1-1 Call Center with information about COVID-positive cases and their addresses.

As of Monday afternoon, Vermilion County was holding at 39 cumulative confirmed cases, Toole said. Of those, none are currently hospitalized, 25 have been released from isolation and one person died.

The most recent case, a person in his 20s, was announced Saturday. Also, as of Saturday, 2,054 people have tested negative for the Chinese virus.

Hoopeston library to offer curbside pickup starting June 1

Effective June 1, Hoopeston Public Library will offer limited checkout services to patrons. The library building will not be open to the public, but staff will

be available by phone.

At this time, library hours will be 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturdays.

Patrons can call the library's main number (217-283-6711) and staff will assist them in selecting books, DVDs or magazines for checkout. A pickup time will be

scheduled, and the library staff will provide no-contact curbside delivery.

Because Illinois Heartland Library System has suspended deliveries during the pandemic, patrons can only request items from Hoopeston's local collection. Checkouts must be made by phone. No online checkouts will be available.

> Library returns can be made curbside by appointment or via the outside book return box. All returned items will be isolated and sanitized before being returned to the collection and redistributed.

Staff will also be available to provide phone assistance with digital services or to answer other questions relating to library

materials.

Public access computer use, photocopying or fax services will not be available. Library programs and meetings remain cancelled.
