VCHD will check data before updating new COVID-19 cases

A handful of errors in classifying county COVID-19 cases were marked is changing how the Vermilion County Health Department will release new information.

Health Administrator Doug Toole said Wednesday that five county cases listed as positive turned out to be negative and 18 others originally assigned to Vermilion County were transferred to where the people actually lived.

The false positives were cases accidentally put in the "COVID-19 positive" database by the labs, he said. Those who were taken out of Vermilion County's statistics were people found to live elsewhere, generally Champaign County, the Chicago area or Indiana, Toole said. The discrepancies were found as part of Vermilion County Health Department's contact tracing efforts.

"For the most part, we became aware of those falsepositive cases and incorrect-address cases prior to posting our updates and did not count them." Toole said. "But in five instances, we did not learn about the false-positive or incorrect address until after the case was posted. I regret the error.

"Going forward, I will delay reporting new positive cases until after our Communicable Disease staff has read though the lab notifications (to ensure that they

were not placed into the COVID-positive database by accident) and contacted the individuals (to confirm their addresses)."

The changes mean that Vermilion County has 43 positive cases, rather than the previously-reported 48. Of those, 34 have been released from isolation and eight are active, with five on home isolation and three hospitalized. One person died from the disease. A total of 3,389 negative tests were reported as of Wednesday.
