Hoopston City Hall reopens to public with limited hours

Hoopston City Hall will reopen to the public Monday morning.
 City offices have been closed as part of Gov. JB Pritzker's Covid-19 emergency plan and are reopening by order of Mayor Bill Crusinberry.
 The reopening process will transition over three weeks, with hours increasing each week.
 This week, city hall will be open from 8-10 a.m.
 June 29-July 2, it will be open from 8 a.m. until noon. The office will be closed Friday, July 3, in observance of Independence Day.
 Starting Monday, July 6, city hall will be open from 8 a.m.-2 p.m.

City to ticket for grass in roads
 Hoopston will begin ticketing those who mow grass into city streets.
 Mowing grass into streets is prohibited by state statute. Additionally, Hoopston ordinance 8.04.040 states: "It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to cast, place, sweep or deposit within the limits of the city any garbage, grass, or other waste matter or rubbish in such a manner that it may be carried or deposited by the action of the wind, rain or snow into or upon street, sidewalk, alley, sewer, parkway or other public place, or unto any occupied or unoccupied premises within the limits of the city."
 The ongoing problem has been discussed by city councils for decades but violators have not been prosecuted.
 Ald. Lourdine Florek, city water committee chairman, has pushed for violators to be ticketed. "This is a problem that actually costs the city money," she said at a recent council meeting. "Grass clogs our sewers and creates problems that we have to pay to fix. Everyone has to pay for a problem caused by a few."

A related ordinance, 8.04.050, states: No pile or deposit of manure, garbage, grass, miscellaneous waste, or refuse of any kind whatsoever, nor accumulation of any offensive or nauseous substance shall be made within the limits of the city, nor shall any person, firm or corporation unload, discharge or put upon the right-of-way of any railroad, street, or public place within the city any manure, garbage, grass, mis-
