77th annual sweet corn festival rescheduled for 2021

In the annals of National Sweetcorn Festival history, 2020 will be remembered along with World War II era as years the harvest celebration was not held.

Hoopeston Jaycees announced Monday evening that the 77th annual festival is postponed until September 2-6, 2021.

The National Sweetcorn Festival, an adaptation of the Hoopeston Sweetcorn Festival, which started in 1935, began in 1941. It was discontinued during the war years, coming back in 1948.

This year, COVID-19 is the cause behind the cancelation.

"After thoughtful discussion with our members, the community, vendors, and our insurance provider; we have made the difficult decision to postpone the 77th National Sweetcorn Festival to September 2-6, 2021," the Jaycees announced in a press release.

"A large part of our decision was based on our insurance provider not covering this year's event," the release stated. "We ask the community to respect our decision-making and we did not come to these conclusions without a lot of thought and input from everyone."

This year's officials - Festival Chairman Joyce Clingenpeel and 2020 Miss Hoopeston Asti Scharlach - will serve in those roles next year. Clingenpeel's logo, featuring "Sassy Sally," will return in 2021, as well.

Clingenpeel said the deciding not to hold a festival this year "was very hard for the Jaycees. We, the Jaycees, have become a family. It's our time to meet up and see people we only get to see once a year. We also get to meet new people from all around the world."

The festival is personal to Clingenpeel, who became part of the Jaycees family about six years ago. "Without the festival, I wouldn't have met my now-husband, P.j. Clingenpeel," who is the festival's annual corn chairman. "The festival is where we met for the first time."

Planning for the 2020 festival began even before the 2019 festival was over, so Clingenpeel has a real head start on 2021, which is expected to include a two-day

tractor pull and possibly two days of demo derby. "They seem to be what the crowd wants to see," she said.

No concert was set for this year and will not be for next year. "The concerts were nice but really didn't bring a crowd in," she said. "We love seeing as many people as we can get in the annex and hope to fill it next year."

Many vendors were hoping to come this year, but Clingenpeel said they asked that, if the festival was canceled, their places be held for next year.

Two added to 60942 total of positive COVID-19 patients

According to information from the Illinois Department of Public Health, the 60942 zip code added two people positive for COVID-19 between Friday and Monday.

The zip code includes Hoopeston and Cheneyville.

Data on the IDPH zip code map Friday showed seven positive cases but the total was at nine Monday.

Vermilion County had been at 67 positive cases but added four on Thursday, two Friday and three Monday, bringing the new total to 76. There are 24 active cases in the county, with 22 on home isolation and two hospitalized, said Doug Toole, Public Health Administrator. Fifty people have been released from isolation and two died.

So far, 6,949 county residents have been tested for the Chinese virus, with 6,873 negative.
