DACC, 14 other community colleges split \$103.5 million

Danville Area Community College is one of 15 community colleges receiving part of more than \$103.5 million to expand existing facilities and construct new buildings, among other projects.

The investments are made possible by Gov. J.B. Pritzker's Rebuild Illinois capital plan.

DACC will receive \$2.3 million to remodel 32,500 square feet of space at the Clock Tower Center, a building from the early 1900s, and for rehabilitation of the Ornamental Horticulture Building, including additions to the greenhouse.

In addition to the \$103.5 million in state funding. the 15 community colleges will receive an additional \$34.5 million in local investments, bringing the total commitment to the projects to \$138 million.

"Community colleges are vital hubs that provide advanced and continuing education, career and technical training, distance learning and workforce development," Pritzker said. "The return on this investment of over \$100 million will be far greater, as these institutions provide close-to-home educational opportunities and the promise of a better future for Illinoisans throughout the state."

Others receiving funding under the program are: Carl Sandburg College, Galesburg, \$422,700; College of DuPage, Glen Ellyn, \$3.3 million; Harper College, Palatine, \$42 million; John A. Logan College, Carterville, \$3.8 million; Lincoln Land Community College, Springfield, \$3.8 million; McHenry County College, Crystal Lake, \$15.8 million; Morton College, Cicero, \$4.9 million; Olney Central College, \$2.3 million, Rend Lake College, Ina, \$5.3 million; Shawnee Community College, Ullin, \$2 million; Southeastern Illinois College, Carmi, \$1.7 million, Spoon River College, Macomb, \$6.1 million; and Triton College, River Grove, \$1.7 million.

Rebuild Illinois will invest 45 billion in roads, brides, railways, universities, early childhood centers and state facilities over the next six years.
