Illinois State Police investigating deaths of two inmates last week at Iroquois County Jail

The deaths of two inmates at the Iroquois County Jail - discovered approximately 15 hours apart - are being investigating by Illinois State Police.

Jason Fancher, 47, of Milford, was found unresponsive in his cell at about 7 p.m. Tuesday. He was taken

to an area hospital, where he later died.

At about 11:15 a.m. Friday, Andre Maiden, 24, of Hoopeston, was found unresponsive in his cell and was later pronounced dead.

Autopsies were to be performed on both men Friday

by the Kankakee County Coroner's office.

Both men were being held on murder charges, Mr. Fancher for the December 13, 2019 murder of Pam Williams, 54, of Sheldon, and Mr. Maiden for the
