Vermilion County in warning for rise in positive virus cases

Vermilion County is one of 30 counties considered to be at a warning level for novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19). A county enters a warning level when two or more risk indicators that measure the amount of COVID-19 increase.

The warning is for the week of August 30-September 5, said Pubic Health Administrator Doug Toole. It is based on the number of new cases per 100,000 and the number of emergency department visits for COVID-19-like illnesses.

A press release on the increase was issued by the Illinois Department of Public Health on Friday afternoon.

are 50 or fewer new positive cases per 100,000 people and a decreasing or stable number of emergency department visits. Vermilion County reported 96 visits per 100,000 and had a 1.5 percent increase in those seeking treatment in emergency departments.

During that week, the county's positivity rate also increased to 3.8 percent, still under the state-mandated level of less or equal to eight percent, but higher than it had been in previous weeks.

Toole said testing was up that week, which normally reduces the positivity rate. "That means we are seeing a wider community spread," he said.

According to the press release, although reasons for counties reaching a warning level varies, some common factors for an increase are associated with college parties, weddings, large gatherings, bars and clubs, long-term care facilities and other congregate settings, travel to neighboring states, and spread among members of the same household who are not isolating at home. Cases connected to schools are beginning to be reported. General transmission of the virus in the community is also increasing, the release said.

Toole said the warning is an opportunity to "remind and encourage businesses and residents to be thoughtful."

If Vermilion and other counties in Region 6 do, too, the state could tighten up some of the guidelines to aid in social distancing and return the region to a lower risk situation, he added.

Other counties in Vermilion's region include Iroquois, Ford, Dewitt, Piatt, Champaign, Madison, Moultrie, Douglas, Edgar, Shelby, Coles, Cumberland, Clark, Fayette, Effingham, Jasper, Crawford, Clay, Richland, and Lawrence.

As of Saturday, Vermilion County had 66 active cases, with four hospitalized and the rest in home isolation. The cumulative number of positive cases is 424, with 21,954 negative test results. Four residents have died of causes related to the novel coronavirus.
