## Honeywell School demolition prep work completed Monday

Jason Redeker and Dan Schroeder, of Lee Farms Excavating, walked around Honeywell School Monday afternoon, discussing where to make the first precision strike to take the building down.

To do that, the men had to know the layout of both the outside and the inside 93-year-old building.

They decided the starting place would be above an open space on the inside of the school, where falling bricks would fill the space, allowing the excavator to continue forward in its work.

Although an excavator had been at the site since last week, a second was brought Monday, along with chain link fence panels to enclose the demolition area. In a corner, a machine that will spray water on the building as it

comes down, sat idle.

Redeker removed the chimney and radio tower Monday afternoon, but serious demolition was expected to begin Tuesday.

An equipment operator the Paxton-based company, Redeker, of Cissna Park, said the plan is take the building down room by room, leaving supporting walls standing until they are all that is left to raze.

The school is a mixture of brick, concrete, metal and wood, which will be separated. Bricks and concrete will be taken to the company's home site, where they will be crushed and sold. Metal will go to a scrap yard and wood will be taken to the landfill. "Separation is the key" to a
