R-Alvin has positive C-19 case

Rossville-Alvin CUSD 7 announced Monday that a positive case of COVID-19 was confirmed in the district.

In a letter to parents and the community, officials did not specify if the person is a child or adult, but said the individual is not currently in school and will follow proper protocols before returning. The potentially-affected areas of the school were disinfected.

The letter said the risk of exposure to the school population is low because during the time others would have been at risk, the person was not in the building, the letter stated that in the event someone is exposed through direct contact - defined as being within six feet of the infected person for at least 15 minutes - the person would be contacted by Vermilion County Health Department.
