Vermilion County reports fifth coronavirus-related death

A 70-year-old Vermilion County resident is the fifth person to die of COVID-19 related causes.

Public Health Administrator Doug Toole announced the man's death on Thursday.

Vermilion County's first death related to the novel coronavirus was announced in April, when a man in his 70s died. Another 70-year-old man died in June, followed by an 80-year-old man in August and a 68-year-old man in September.

Several new cases were reported last week: 17 on Monday, 18 Tuesday, 27 on Wednesday, 31 on Thursday, 22 Friday, 44 on Saturday and 12 Sunday.

Vermilion County has had 809 positive cases, 176 of which are currently active. Of those, seven are hospitalized and the rest on home isolation.

In the last week, two cases were within the

Hoopeston Area school district and one in the Rossville-Alvin district.

The county is at a warning level for new cases for the week of September 20-26, with total new cases per 100,000 at 237. The state metric is less than 50 per 100,000.

Although missing the mark, Vermilion County is not under official state warning related to the virus, which originated in Wuhan, China.

Hoopeston's cumulative positive cases rose two, to 39, according to information Monday from the Illinois Department of Public Health. Rossville was holding at 13.

Around the area, other communities and their totals include Potomac, 23; Alvin, eight, Bismarck 10; Milford 14, Cissna Park 19; and Watseka 57.
