Parents must decide by October 9 if changing learning method

Hoopeston Area parents have until October 9 to notify school officials if they want to change their students' instructional method.

Supt. Robert Richardson recently announced the option to change.

Currently, the district offers five-day, in-school learning at grade schools and, at the middle/high schools, four-day, in-school learning with Wednesdays as an all-remote learning day. All have a shortened school day.

Parents at all levels may choose to have their children do all remote learning and children who have tested positive for COVID-19 are put on remote learning during their quarantine period.

At the beginning of the school year, each family chose an educational method, whether in-school or remote. As the first quarter comes to an end, district officials are allowing families to make a change, if they want.

Parents who want to make a change are asked to call their child's school. Second quarter choices will take ef-

fect October 19.

In August, Richardson released enrollment numbers and educational methods selected. Of a total 1,062 students, 792 selected in-person learning, with 270 opting for remote learning. By building, the numbers were:

Richardson also announced that parent/teacher conferences will be held October 21-22, from 3-6:30 p.m., and may be held in person, virtually or by phone. Parents are asked to contact their child's teacher to set up an appointment and method for the conference.
