County COVID-19 cases jump; second grade on remote learning

Vermilion County on Tuesday saw its biggest jump yet in the number of positive COVID-19 cases.

Public Health Administrator Doug Toole announced 79 new positive cases Tuesday evening, including a 90-year-old, six people in their 70s, seven people in their 60s, 11 in their 40s, nine each in their 20s and 30s, 10 teens, nine grade-school age children, one toddler and an infant.

Twenty-five of the new cases are family-related to new or previously reported cases, he said.

The addition brings the county's cumulative positive total to 914. Of those, 228 are active, with seven people hospitalized and the rest on in-home isolation. Five people have died.

There have been 28,977 negative results, Toole added.

According to information from Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), Vermilion County has had 10 confirmed cases in county nursing homes and no deaths.

IDPH had no new cases listed Wednesday for the 60942 zip code, which includes Hoopeston and Cheneyville. The area remained at 39 positive cases.

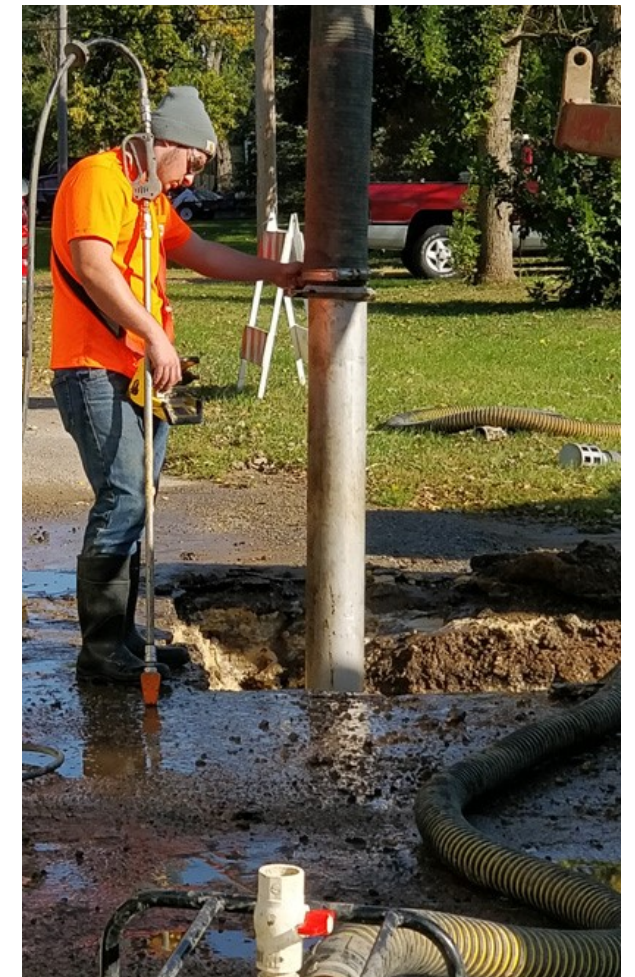
Rossville's total grew by one, now at 14. Bismarck's total went up three to 13. Alvin and Potomac remain at eight and 24, respectively.

In Iroquois County, Watseka's total climbed by two, to 59. Milford and Cissna Park stayed the same, at 14 and 19, respectively.

In related news, Hoopeston Area Supt. Robert Richardson said second graders will use remote learning through October 16 after the district was notified of a positive case resulting in implementing its procedures for close contact into motion.

"Due to the fact students are eating lunch in the classroom and specialty classes are going to the classrooms, we were able to limit the contact to the second grade," he said.

A new confirmed case was reported at Hoopeston Area Middle School Wednesday.
