Free electronics collection to be held Saturday at DACC

Vermilion County residents have one shot to get rid of televisions and computer monitors this year.

A free electronics collection will be held from 9-11 a.m. Saturday at Danville Area Community College, 2000 E. Main St., Danville.

This will be the only collection this year that will accept computer monitors and televisions, said Brenda Adams, director of event co-sponsor Keep Vermilion County Beautiful, at last week's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Other sponsors are Vermilion County Health Department, DACC, Vermilion County and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Televisions may be CRT or tube models, flat screen or LCD; CRT monitors, flat screen or LCD monitors; com-

puters, printers, electronic keyboards, fax machines, VCRs, portable digital music players, video disc players, video game consoles, electronic mice, scanners, converter boxes, able receivers, satellite receivers and video disc recorders.

There is a limit of seven items per vehicle. Items must be in enclosed trunks, truck beds or trailers and not in the front or back seats of vehicles.

The event is free to any Vermilion County resident; proof of residency will be required.

Donations to Keep Vermilion County Beautiful for future events will be accepted during the collection.

Local recycling companies do not take TVs or computer monitors but accept many electronics items for recycling or reprocessing during their normal business hours.

Weekend Covid cases see slower increase, Wellington on map

While Vermilion County's total number of COVID-19 cases continues to rise, weekend numbers were lower than those last week.

Public Health Administrator Doug Toole announced 224 new cases between October 4-9. Two deaths were also reported: A 70-year-old man on Thursday and an 80-year-old man Friday.

On Saturday, 17 new cases were added to the total, and another 10 on Sunday, bringing the total positive cases to 1,060. Of those, 253 are active, with nine in the hospital and the rest in home isolation. There have been seven deaths and 30,243 negative test results.

Closer to home, Hoopeston had a sharp climb in positive test results, moving from 39 late last week to 58 reported Sunday. The number remained steady for Monday's Illinois Department of Public Health update.

A new community was added to the IDPH map over the weekend. The map shows communities in the state with more than five cases. Wellington debuted with six but Monday's report added two more.

Other area communities and their totals include:

Rossville 16, Alvin, holding at eight; Potomac, an increase of one to 25; Rankin 9; and Bismarck 17.

In Iroquois County, Cissna Park rose from 19 to 22, Milford's total went up from 14 to 20 and Watseka's number of confirmed positive tests went from 59 to 64.

Toole encouraged county residents to eat healthy, exercise, hydrate, get enough rest and wash their hands. Residents should wear masks and social distance. Two ways to support local service providers, schools and small businesses, he said, would be to stay home when you are sick, and to avoid gatherings where social distancing will be difficult.
