#### County sees 40 more positives

Vermilion County added 40 more positive COVID-19 tests Wednesday, bringing the county to 1,152 positive cases, said Public Health Administrator Doug Toole on Wednesday.

New cases include two 70-year-olds, two 60-yearolds, seven people in their 50s, six in their 40s, 12 in their 30s, four in their 20s, four teens, a grade-school aged youngster and two preschoolers. Thirteen of the new cases are family-related to new or previously reported cases.

Of the 1,152, 232 are active cases. Additionally, 32 cases were recovered/released from isolation Wednesday. There have been 32,061 negative tests.

Locally, much of the local area is holding steady at Wednesday's numbers, including Hoopeston, Rossville, Alvin, Bismarck, Potomac, Rankin, along with Cissna Park, Milford, Wellington and Watseka.
