Rise slows on number of new area COVID-19 positives

The number of novel coronavirus cases continues to increase but at a much slower pace than in recent weeks.

After some daily increases of 40 to almost 80 positive tests at the county level, and leaps of positives for the 60942 zip code, Public Health Administrator Doug Toole announced 11 new cases Sunday and 21 Monday at the county level.

Meanwhile, Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) information Tuesday morning showed an additional six positive tests in 60942, to 107.

That is the cumulative number of positive test results for Hoopeston and Cheneyville. The number of current active cases in the zip code is not provided by IDPH.

Vermilion County currently has 177 active cases. Of those, 163 are on home isolation and 14 are hospitalized. There have been 1,507 total confirmed cases, with 1,318 released/recovered and 12 deaths.

Total negative tests number 36,296.

Although the county's average positive rate is 7.7 - down from 8.3 - it is on the state's warning list for numbers the week of October 11-17.

That week, the county had 337 new cases per 100,000 residents, far above the state maximum of 50 See POSITIVES on other side

per 100,000. The 9.5 positive rate that week was 9.5, above Gov. JB Pritzker's maximum of eight percent.

Vermilion County was also in warning territory for adult emergency department visits, at 5.2 percent hospital admissions for patients with Covid-like symptoms, at 22 for the week.

The target in both categories is decreasing or stable numbers for the week.

Despite the increases, Vermilion County's ICU bed availability of 46.1 percent is above the state standard of 20 percent.

In the surrounding area, some communities have seen increases in the Chinese virus, while others remain stable.

Those with no changes include Alvin, 8; Bismarck, 19; Rankin, 14; Rossville, 20; and Wellington, nine.

Potomac has had five additional positive tests since last week and is now at 31. In Iroquois County, Cissna Park's total went up three, to 29. Milford's total was at 23 last week and was at 27 Tuesday. Watseka's total Tuesday was 70, up one from last week.

The percentage of men and women who have tested positive remains the same at 48 and 52, respectively. By age range, positive testing numbers are:
