Voters to head to polls for county, state and federal decisions

Hoopeston residents, like those across America, will go to the polls today, as candidates from the county level to the presidency will be decided.

Vermilion County has two races, as Democrats have challenged Republican incumbents for both state's attorney and circuit clerk.

Melissa Quick, current circuit clerk, is being challenged by Gwendolyn Meeks. Incumbent Jacqueline M. Lacy is facing a challenged from attorney Sandra L. Lawlves.

Hoopeston Area Supt. Robert Richardson loads bricks from Honeywell School into a waiting vehicle. Richardson donated his time to collect 450 bricks during the school's demolition and on Saturday, donated more time fetching bricks from a utility trailer and loading them into people's vehicles. Brick distribution started at 9 a.m. Richardson said he arrived at the school to find people parked and waiting. About 100 cars went through in the first half hour, then slowed afterwards. About 120 bricks remained at the noon deadline. Built in 1927, Honeywell School was demolished last month "I understand people wanting to hold on to a memory of Honeywell and the District wants to assist in that endeavor," Richardson said.
