Mitigations continue, local communities see numbers rise

Positive COVID-19 tests continue to rise across cities, counties, states and the nation.

Due to increased numbers, all of Illinois is under Gov. J.B. Pritzker's enhanced mitigations that forbid indoor drinking and dining, among other measures.

Vermilion County remains on the state's warning list, both for new cases per 100,000 - at 333, with a target of 50 - for the week of October 25-31, as well as test positivity, at 12 percent, four points over the target of eight percent, and tests performed at 2,141, not enough to keep the county under the eight percent positivity mandate.

Public Health Administrator Doug Toole said the county will be on the list for at least another week due to last week's numbers.

Earlier in October, Vermilion County was on the warning list for the number of emergency department visits and hospital admissions, but has seen stable or decreasing numbers in those areas.

As of Sunday, Vermilion County had reached a total 1,913 positive cases. Of those, 231 were active, with 21 residents hospitalized. The number of negative tests stands at 40,107.

Since the pandemic began, the county has had 14 - or 20 - deaths, depending on which source is used.

Toole reported errors in the county's death total on

November 2, which put the number at 12. However, two 80-year-old men, who had previously been hospitalized, brought to number to 14.

On November 3, another error was reported, which lowered the number to 13.

On November 4, a man in his 70s, who also had been hospitalized, died from Covid-related illness, bringing the total back to 14.

According to IDPH information, Vermilion County has had 20 deaths thus far.

Closer to home, communities in Vermilion and Iroquois counties had increases in the number of positive

tests.

In the last 12 days, the 60942 zip code saw an increase from 107 to 171. Rossville's total on Sunday was 37, up from 20. Alvin, which has been steady at eight positives for several weeks, jumped to 13.

Bismarck also saw a leap, going from 19 to 33 positive tests. Potomac, which had been at 31, is now at

46, while Rankin is at 25, up from 14.

Danville's 61832 and 61834 has a cumulative total 1,344 total positives.

In Iroquois County, Cissna Park experienced an increase from 29 to 72 positive tests, while Milford went from 27 to 46. Wellington, which had been at nine, added two.
