**Movie package brings families together at Little Lorraine**

If your family is having withdrawals from not being able to munch popcorn and watch a movie at the Little Lorraine, Save the Lorraine Foundation has your fix.

Starting this week, the foundation is offering the Little Lorraine Family Movie Pack, a private showing of a family-friendly film for up to 12 people. Each viewing includes unlimited pop and popcorn, all for \$75. Candy and Dippin' Dots will be available for purchase.

Film fans can schedule a private showing at 1, 4 or 7 p.m. of a list of movies including:

- November 21 The Lion King (2019)
- November 28 Finding Nemo
- December 5 Frozen II filled
- December 12 We Bought a Zoo
- December 19 Polar Express
- December 26 The Call of the Wild

Due to the rise of the number of Covid cases in the community, the foundation canceled public showings and is now only offering private parties, said Alex Houmes, foundation vice president. "With so many events canceled this year, we wanted to offer an affordable private showing package that would allow families to get out and do something fun, but still limit their contact with others."

Moviegoers will be required to wear masks in the lobby, but not once they're seated in the auditorium. "The Little Lorraine Family Movie Pack is for groups we assume have been together already," Houmes said.

A UV air purified is installed in the theater, staff thoroughly clean, and sanitize between showings, he added.

The price is a great deal for families. Normal admission is \$5 per person and \$2 for children, plus the cost of snacks. That money is used to pay to keep the lights and heat on and other bills. What many people don't realize, Houmes said, is the theater has to pay licensing fees to show the movies. Those fees range from \$250-\$500 per weekend.

Due to current times, the Little Lorraine's booking agent was able to provide - for a limited time - discount-

ed licensing for small private showings. "This allowed us to create a private party package affordable enough for single families to attend," Houmes said. "Although we do have bills to pay, providing an affordable cinematic experience that all can enjoy is the Little Lorraine's mission."

For those who would like a private party, with more guests or a different day, the Little Lorraine offers package for \$150, Houmes added.

COVID-19 guidelines could alter the foundation's plan, but Houmes said those who have reserved a time and movie may either reschedule or receive a refund.
