Prison outbreak continues to boost county positive numbers

Vermilion County positive Covid cases continues to rise, fueled, in part, by a continued outbreak at Danville Correctional Center.

In an update Sunday, Public Health Administrator Doug Toole announced 107 new cases, with 28 coming from "a congregate-living facility that is experiencing a severe COVID-19 outbreak. Since November 14, 774

residents of this facility have tested positive for COVID-19."

Positive cases by local communities is posted in the chart below left.

Vermilion County has had 6,583 total positives as of Sunday. Of those, 595 are active. Currently, 25 Covidpositive residents are hospitalized and 81 citizens have died of Covid-related disease.

There have been 75,457 negative test results in the county, Toole said.

Having received vaccine shipments, healthcare workers are being immunized against the virus. Last week, 320 workers were vaccinated and two clinics are scheduled this week, he said.

According to Illinois Department of Public Health, Illinois is currently is Phase 1a of its vaccine plan, which focuses on healthcare workers, as well as residents and personnel in long-term care congregate care facilities, where high rates of transmission and outbreaks can occur.

In a hospital setting, those eligible for the vaccine include all those providing patient care and treatment, along with clergy and chaplains, interpreters, laundry, security and reception staff, EMS, fire department staff acting as EMS.

Healthcare workers in medical outpatient facilities, public health clinics, federally qualified health centers, as well as longer-care and other congregate care facilities are also eligible, as are home aide/caregivers. Residents of those facilities are also prioritized.

Vaccine is in short supply but is expected to become more readily available as the year progresses.
