### Eckersley resigns township seat to move, Miller to replace

Grant Township Trustee Mike Eckersley was honored at Tuesday's monthly trustees meeting for his service on the board.

Eckersley resigned his seat because he and his wife, Sandy, are moving to Florida soon. Eckersley has served on the town board since 2005.

Sherry Miller, one of four candidates selected at the Republican caucus in December, was appointed to fill his position until May, when trustees elected in the April election will be seated.

This is not the first time he has resigned elected office to move. A former Hoopeston alderman, he stepped down in 2002 when he moved to his current residence, on the north side of Thompson, outside of Ward 2 and the city limits. He was replaced by current Ald. Carl Ankenbrand.

## Miller, Kinzinger on opposite sides of Trump impeachment

Local U.S. representatives were split Tuesday on the impending vote on impeaching President Donald Trump..

Rep. Mary Miller (15-IL) and Rep. Adam Kinzinger (16-IL) each issued statements Tuesday on the issue. Miller wrote:

"What this country desperately needs now is unity and healing. Impeaching the President with just eight days left in his term will only divide us further. Each passing day spent on these articles is an opportunity lost to working on the priorities of our American families.

"President Trump will leave behind a legacy filled with remarkable achievements, including the protection of the unborn, creation of the world's greatest economy, the restoration of American manufacturing, historic deregulation, secure borders, the negotiation of fair and balanced trade deals along with promoting peace around the world.

"I will oppose any articles set forth to impeach our President and pray for the immediate peace we need." Kinzinger stated:

"Throughout my time in Congress, I've sought to do the right thing for the good of the people I represent and for the country as a whole. We are in unchartered waters here, and in a moment in history we have not experienced in modern times.

"On January 6, 2021, the President of the United States encouraged an angry mob to storm the United States Capitol to stop the counting of electoral votes. This angry mob turned violent and caused destruction to our nation's symbol of democracy. This insurrection led to countless injuries and the death of several people, including two of our U.S. Capitol Police Officers.


#### Fire Calls
