Confusion between IDPH, governor's office over Region 6 Covid mitigations cleared

Gov. J.B. Prizker and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) sent out contradictory information Friday on Region 6's place in the governor's Covid mitigation ranking.

Region 6 includes Vermilion and Iroquois counties, along with Champaign, Clark, Clay, Coles, Crawford, Cumber-land, DeWitt, Douglas, Edgar, Effingham, Fayette, Ford, Jasper, Lawrence, Macon, Moultrie, Piatt, Richland and Shelby counties.

Region 6 was moved to Tier 3 on November 2. The tier banned indoor dining, bar service and a host of other activities, in an effort to stop the spread of Covid-19. The entire state was moved to the level on November 20, but on Friday, Pritzker announced regions 1, 2, and 5 would move to Tier 2. The remaining eight regions were to remain at Tier 3.

However, on its website, IDPH announced that the Tier 3 mitigation freeze was released and all but two regions - 4 and 7 - were moving out of the tier Friday.

Region 6, along with 1 and 2, moved to Tier 1, while regions 8-11 moved to Tier 2. Regions 3 and 5 were placed back in Phase 4, the most lenient category short of full opening. Early on, Pritzker said Illinois would not fully reopen until an effective treatment or vaccine became available or if no new cases were reported over a sustained period.

The confusion was cleared Monday with reports of Region 6 reopening under Tier 1 guidelines:

Restaurants/bars - indoor service limited to the lesser of 25 percent or 25 people per room. Tables must be spaced 6' apart and no tables exceeding four people indoors. Service is suspended if not serving food. All bars and restaurants must close at 11 p.m. and reopen no earlier than 6 a.m. the following day. Reservations required for each party. Dancing or standing indoors is prohibited.

Fitness centers - open following Phase 4 guidelines. Indoor fitness classes may resume under Phase 4 guidelines.

Gatherings - Limit of 25 guests or 25 percent of capacity, indoors or outdoors.

Theaters - may open under Phase 4 guidelines.

Video gaming is also allowed under Tier 1, during the limited 6 a.m.-11 p.m. hours of operation, but gaming machines were not turned on until Tuesday morning.

Regions were allowed to move from Tier 3 - or not based on whether they met goals in Pritzker's plan to curb the novel coronavirus. Criteria include all of the following: less than 12% test positivity rate (sevenday rolling average) for three consecutive days; greater than or equal to 20% percent available intensive

care unit (ICU) (seven-day rolling average) for three consecutive days, and a decline in the number of COVID-19 patients in the hospital (seven-day rolling average) in 7 out of the last 10 days.

Data for the week of January 8-17 show Region 6 had a seven-day test positivity rate of 6.7 percent, ICU bed availability of 28 percent and a decrease from 190 to 180 patients in the hospital.
