State reduces Region 6 coronavirus restrictions for second time in less than a week

For the second time in less than a week, Covid-19 miti-
 gations have been lightened in Region 6.

Effective Thursday, the counties of Region 6, including
 Vermilion, Iroquois, Champaign, Clark, Clay, Coles,
 Crawford, Cumberland, DeWitt, Douglas, Edgar, Eff-
 ingham, Fayette, Ford, Jasper, Lawrence, Macon,

Moultrie, Piatt, Richland and Shelby, had coronavirus
 restrictions eased a little more, moving to Phase 4 of Gov.
 J.B. Pritzker's Covid-19 response plan.

Phase 4 includes many of the same Illinois Department
 of Public Health guidelines as Tier 3. However, indoor
 bar service can resume without the restriction of serving

food and gatherings of 50 people or 25 percent of capaci-
 ty will be allowed.

The region was last in Phase 4 from late June to the end
 of November of last year.

To open totally, Pritzker's plan calls for an effective
 treatment, vaccine or no new cases over a sustained peri-
 od.

Vaccines have been developed and are being provided
 to Illinois residents. In Vermilion County, 1,800 doses
 were administered as of Wednesday, said Public Health
 Director Doug Toole. Of those, 610 were administered
 by the department and the rest by hospitals, the VA Med-
 ical Center and pharmacies. There have been about 1,100
 first doses and more than 100 second doses, he said.
