Spread of positive Covid-19 cases in local communities slows

The number of new cases of Covid-19 is slowing and in some cases, at a standstill - in area communities over the last week.

Hoopeston, which has seen increases by dozens some weeks, added 11 to its total number of positive cases in the last week and is now at 610.

Most gains in other communities followed by Just

the Facts remained in the low single digits: Alvin gained 3, Potomac gained 1, Rossville gained six and Rankin lost one - most likely a person counted in Rankin's total who was later found not to live in the village.

Bismarck gained no new positive cases, holding steady at 123.

Public Health Administrator Doug Toole on Sunday announced another 52 new cases in Vermilion County, bringing the total number since the pandemic started to 7,158. Of those, 22 are currently hospitalized, 91 have died.

State Mobile Testing Teams will have four upcoming visits at the Vermilion County Health Department. Drive-through/walk up testing will be available at the department from 8 a.m.-3:30 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday this week and on Saturday and Sunday, February 6-7, next week.

No appointment is necessary. Testing is open to Illinois or Indiana residents, adults and children, with or without symptoms. There is no cost for testing but insurance information will be collected for billing. Insurance is not required for testing.

With the state online appointment system not working, VCHD is requesting that those who wish to receive Covid-19 vaccines call the health department, (217) 431-2662, ext. 243. Callers will be placed on a waiting list for the limited supply of vaccine available to Vermilion County.

The health department is currently administering second doses to those who received their first vaccine in early January and first vaccines to county educa-

Three vaccination clinics will be held at the Fischer Theater on February 11, 18, and 25 which will be open to seniors ages 65 and older. March vaccination sessions have not yet been announced.
