

Lorraine Foundation takes Sewing Boutique building, new business to open this week

Well, that was quick.

Last year, Vera Keller and Joyce Stock, decided to close The Sewing Boutique after 40 years in business. The women decided to give the building, at 222 E. Main, to the Save the Lorraine Foundation, which took place last month.

On Friday, a new business will open at that address, creating a new reason for people to shop downtown Hoopeston.

The Sewing Boutique opened in the summer of 1980. LaVawn Forshier had the idea for a fabric and notions shop and asked Vera Keller if she was interested in joining in the venture. They had the thought that having three owners would be less risky and asked Joyce Stock to be a partner. Keller and Stock were both former home economics teachers, giving them the experience needed to make the business successful.

The Sewing Boutique opened in a building west of the railroad track on West Penn. The business soon outgrew Penn Street and it moved to 222 E Main in 1983.

Forshier retired in 1984 and moved to Florida. Joyce and Vera continued in the business for 40 years. They sold fabric and taught people how to sew and make quilts.

The Sewing Boutique was a one-stop shop. Along with fabrics and classes, customers could also purchase sewing machines, as well as notions to express their creativity.

For the women, the store was a lifelong love and one they enjoyed. They met people from all over Illinois, including Chicago, and from Indiana, as well. People traveled great distances to learn from Vera and Joyce.

They chose to donate the building to Lorraine Foundation, whose goal is to continue to improve the downtown area. Keller knew the building would be taken care of and repurposed for a new occupant.

Asked why the foundation would take on another empty building, group President Jim Richards said it fills the foundation philosophy and mission which is "to do everything we can to improve the status of downtown.

"People are willing to come to a friendly space and the new owner is repurposing the building for a retail business," Richards said, declining to reveal what business would fill the space.
