IDPH works with local health departments to balance first, second Covid vaccine doses

Due to the number of people requiring the second dose of the Covid-19 vaccine and with limited federal shipments to the state, fewer doses are available for first-time inoculations.

Beginning Monday, local health departments and other providers of the vaccine were to receive a larger share of second doses to make sure those who received the first dose get the second in a timely manner.

Based on federal projections of vaccine shipments, Illinois Department of Pubic Health (IDPH) expects these allocations to hold steady for the next several weeks before allocations of first doses can once again

increase in March.

Both the Moderna and Pfizer vaccines require a second dose, three weeks after the first dose for the Moderna vaccine and four weeks after the first dose for those who receive Pfizer.

In a press release, IDPH said it has communicated extensively with local health department and others to prepare for the shift in allocations, including webinars, individual planning calls and rapid electronic notification to all vaccine providers.

In Vermilion County, Public Health Administrator Doug Toole said Vermilion County Health Department has enough vaccine on hand to provide second-dose and first-dose vaccinations for all those scheduled for the February 18 and 25 clinics at the Fischer Theater.

“We have been told that the state will provide us with enough vaccine to provide second-dose vaccinations to everyone who receive a first-dose vaccination in February, so we plan to hold second-dose vaccination clinics at the Fischer in March,” he said.

Toole expects the department will begin scheduling people to receive first-dose vaccines when it has enough vaccine to do so. ‘It is our hope that we will be able to make appointments for people to receive their first-dose vaccinations in early March,” he said.

On Sunday, Toole announced 42 new positive cases, bringing the current number of active cases to 328.

City Police department warns of telephone fundraising scam

Hoopeston Police Department is reporting that residents have received telephone calls from an organization purporting to be raising money to fund the police.

Hoopeston Police Department has not and is not sponsoring any fundraising.

Of those, 12 are hospitalized and the rest on home isolation.
