

All hands pitch in to move Hoopeston's 'I walked to school in a blizzard' snow accumulation

Even though it happened on Presidents' Day and school was not in session, Monday's snow was one of those "I walked a mile to school and back in a blizzard" kind of storms.

For the first time in a long time, Hoopeston and the surrounding area experienced double-digit accumulation which was coupled with high winds.

Hoopeston implemented a new, recently-approved plan that uses not only street and alley employees, but also parks and water department workers, to clean up after large snows.

Ald. Jeff Wise, street/alley committee chairman, said roughly 10" of snow fell on Hoopeston. As his depart-

ment plowed streets, water workers cleared the area around the water plant, both fire stations, city hall and around Schumacher's, which there is a lot of drifting, he said.

Meanwhile, park employees cleaned up the park, the area around the annex and part of Maple.

The plan calls for parks workers to also plow alleys "but the snow depth was an issue in some places with their truck," Wise said. Alleys are an issue due to drifting, but we'll get to them as soon as we can. The main roads have to be done first."
