Members of Hoopeston Fire Department, along with Vermilion County and Hoopeston dispatchers and animal control officers and a couple of local men worked together Sunday to rescue a dog who had fallen through the ice on a pond at 42025 N 1900 E Rd.

Vermilion County dispatch center got the call about the dog and passed the information on to the Hoopeston center. Fire fighters Troy Leroy Stevens and Maggie Bartley responded and residents John Yaden and Pete Polomski were able to rescue the dog from the water and bring it to shore.

Sherry Klemme, Hoopeston animal control officer, and Kathleen Orcutt, Vermilion County's animal control officer, worked behind the scenes to identify the dog and her owner.

After being checked on scene, the thankful pooch received a checkup from an area veterinarian before returning home.
