Hoopeston pool to be closed, council approves ordinance officer

For the second season in a row, Hoopeston's swimming pool will be closed.

Due to a lack of interest by young people to work as lifeguards, the pool will not open, Ald. Lourdine Florek announced at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meet-

Last year, she said, the city advertised for lifeguards before Covid-19 hit and received very few applications. Covid restrictions then kept the pool from opening.

This year, Florek said she asked people with ties to groups for young people to personally recruit lifeguard candidates, again with no success.

Considering the lack of lifeguard candidates, needed repairs to the pool and bathhouse and the fact that pool has run at a deficit for years, Florek suggested the council should look at whether it should be permanently closed, and suggested the parks committee should oversee that discussion. By ordinance, the pool is under the parks committee, but was unofficially put under the water department in 2019.

Mayor Bill Crusinberry suggested the council meet as a committee of the whole to discuss and decide.

Asked about the splash pad, Florek said it will be open, as it was last year. She added that if the pool is permanently closed, she would like to see the splash pad expanded to include features for older youngsters to enjoy.

In other business, the council approved Steve Bane as the city's new ordinance officer in an 8-0 vote.

Crusinberry said the city advertised for two or three months and received only a handful of applications, none of which were what he was looking for. Last week, Bane went to city hall to talk to Crusinberry about his interest in the position. The two talked and Crusinberry decided to recommend him for the job.

Bane, a retired Hoopeston police officer, also served as Rankin Police Chief, where he handled code enforcement, Crusinberry said in making the recommendation.

Bane's first day in the new position will be March 29. In unrelated discussion, Crusinberry said Hoopeston's cemetery records are online and will go live Monday.
