# WHY RE★ELECT MAYOR BILL CRUSINBERRY?

## Infrastructure



I was elected to the City Council in 2005 and was named Water/Sewer Committee chairman. There was much to learn about those systems since both are heavily regulated by the Illinois EPA. Luckily, we have excellent employees who helped me gain basic knowledge. Early on, I discovered our water system was badly in need of upgrades and replacement. The two storage tanks, water tower and ½ million ground storage tank had to be sand blasted, painted, and upgraded to comply with today's standards. I learned there was no plan to do this work. Adding to the problem,

the Water/Sewer fund had been operating at a deficit for years, supported by the general fund. The Council approved an Infrastructure Maintenance Fee to create funds to remedy some of these much-needed upgrades.

We applied for an Illinois clean water loan in 2006 and reapplied yearly until finally receiving a \$3 million loan 6 years later. With this, we refurbished the two existing tanks and built a new aeration system. We also refurbished our three filters. The result: we have a storage and treatment facility that is totally compliant with current EPA standards.

During this time, we received a \$750,000 grant to install a new water main from the water plant to the corner of Rt. 1 and Thompson Ave. This main serves the new nursing home and supplies better water pressure and fire protection for the Northwest part of the city.

Another recently-completed project was the lining of a north side sanitary sewer that had massive amounts of storm water leaching into it. Approximate cost \$770,000.

To date we have done nearly \$5.5 million of upgrades with approximately 1.75 million done with state funds that do not have to be repaid. These projects are being paid for with the Infrastructure Maintenance Fee, your money at work. Moving forward, Water Supt. Baker, Chrm. Florek, and I have created a priority list to keep the progress going.

I would like to be elected for another term as your Mayor to see that the programs we have in place are brought to completion.
