# WHY RE\*ELECT MAYOR BILL CRUSINBERRY? More on Infrastructure

Since I believe the infrastructure of a city is similar to our body's skeleton - it supports everything else - I would like to follow up on my last article and touch on projects we have in progress and some that we are working on for the near future.

First would be the refurbishing of Thompson Ave. Following the completion of North Market St., we began setting aside our annual allotment of Federal road funds to pay for 80% of this project and the other 20% would be funded with Illinois' Rebuild Illinois Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) special allotment. What this means is that MFT funds that Hoopeston had been setting aside to fund our 20%, (about \$220,000) can now be used for other projects, but we will not be looking to spend this newfound funding all at once, since you never know when emergency repairs might pop up and a little reserve fund is a good thing. The total cost of this project will be approx. 1 million dollars and should be started in the spring of 2022.

Next, we were notified by the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity that we had been awarded a \$400,000 grant from the Capitol Bill of several years ago. This grant was requested by our State Representative Tom Bennett in the amount of \$500,000 and we received 80%. We are now completing necessary documentation and preliminary engineering on replacing a partially collapsed sanitary sewer between Washington and Lincoln from 6th St. to Euclid Ave.

We are also working on a grant to make some necessary repairs at the Sewage Treatment Plant, approx. cost, \$250,00-400,000, yet to be determined.

Finally, we are awaiting the awarding of grants from the Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grants program. With the assistance of the Champaign County Regional Planning Commission, we applied for a \$1.1 million grant to install all the infrastructure. (street, water main, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer) for the undeveloped 5.5 acres on Rt. 9 between Marathon and the former Star Chrysler, now the Pink Poodle.

Of these projects, two totaling 1.5 million dollars have been awarded. If the other two are awarded, we will be looking at nearly 3 million dollars of upgrades, funded with state and federal money.

I would like to be elected for another term as your Mayor to see that the programs we have in place are brought to completion.

Beginning Monday April 12, all Illinoisans over age 16 will be eligible to receive their vaccination, state Rep. Tom Bennett announced recently.

Late last week Illinois surpassed five million doses administered since the first vaccinations began in December 2020. The vast majority of these are twoshot vaccinations, so it will take more than 26 million doses to fully vaccinate the state's entire population.

The Department of Public Health has been working with local health departments, community health centers, pharmacies and many other health providers in the state to reach as many Illinoisans as possible. As of Thursday just over 15% of Illinoisans were fully vaccinated.

Vaccines are administered by appointment only, so anyone seeking to obtain one will need an appointment to do so. Residents can do so through the Vermilion County Health Department website, www.vchd.org, visit coronavirus.illinois.gov or call the Department of Public Health hotline at 1-833-621 -1284.
