City council to use reserves to fund pool for another year

At a budget meeting Wednesday evening, Hoopeston City Council approved using reserve funds to open the city swimming pool this year.

Ald. Bill Goodwine, finance committee chairman, suggested using \$68,000 from the accrual fund to open the pool this year, based on pleas from a group formed to save the pool. The amount is an average of the pool deficits in the last three or four years, he said.

Members of the newly formed Save the Hoopeston Public Swimming Pool attended Tuesday night's city council meeting offering to help raise funds, find employees and expand programs to entice more people to use the pool and asked that the city fund the pool this year.

Hoopeston and area residents asking that the pool remain open. Group members also attended Wednesday's budget The proposed overrides an announcement made at the March 16 council meeting by water committee chairman Ald. Lourdine Florek, that, due to 10 years of deficits

totaling roughly \$776,000 and a lack of public interest in using it, the pool would not open. She suggested the council discuss the possibility of permanently closing it and expanding the splash pad to include features for older youth to enjoy.

At Tuesday's meeting, Kim Burch, representing the

group, also presented petitions to the council signed by

The proposed general budget includes \$2,330,793 in revenue and expenses totaling \$1,925,668 in expenses and \$229,840 in accruals for major purchases, such as new vehicles and large equipment. Those deductions left a balance of \$175,285 but departments had submitted \$418,780 in one-time expenses, including set-asides for demolition of commercial buildings, blacktopping Floral Hill roads, along with smaller items.

It was suggested to use an expected \$300,000 in Covid relief funds to offset some of the one-time items that meet criteria for the Covid funds.

The council is expected to approve the budget at its April 20 meeting.


