Governing bodies list policies for graves in area cemeteries

Area cemeteries are advising residents of policies enforced at each one.

Floral Hill Cemetery, Hoopeston:

- Stay off grass. Park on roads only at all times. No unlicensed vehicles, ATVs, dirt bikes or skateboards allowed in cemetery.
- No planting of trees, shrubs, bushes, flowers, etc.
- No bordering of graves with metal frames, crushed stone, fences or other materials permitted.
- No placing boxes, shells, toys, metal designs, frames, ornaments, chairs, settees, wood or iron cases, glass, anything breakable or any other articles upon lots and/or monuments.
- Flowers to be planted in urns or hanging baskets. No covering full or partial graveside with flowers or any other material.
- Grave blankets, half blankets, wreaths and bouquets are allowed during non-mowing season and must have plastic spikes. No metal spikes.
- Artificial decorations and flowers are permitted in metal or plastic vases. Saddles are allowed to be placed on stones. No glass allowed and no flowers to be stuck in the ground.
- For maintenance purposes, decorations must be removed as follows:
 - OWinter decorations first Monday in March
- OSpring/Sumner decorations third Monday in September
- The city cannot guarantee decorations from damage or disappearance.
- Footstones allowed but must be flush with the ground and installed by a professional upon approval of cemetery management.
- Benches allowed as part of memorial and must be approved by cemetery management.
- No dog walking or running of dogs allowed in cemetery.
- Vaults are required for all burials.
- Cemetery is open from dawn to dusk.

Ross/South Ross Cemetery District

Policies cover Rossville, Mann's Chapel and Bethel cemeteries.

- The district cannot guarantee decorations from damage or theft.
- Spring/summer decorations are allowed March 15-October 15.
- No spring/summer decorations or planters are allowed on the ground.
- Spring/summer decorations must use saddles, gravestone vases or shepherd's hooks.
- No planting of any kind, such as flowers, shrubs, trees.
- Decorations are to be placed on monument or monument base.
- 1 shepherd's hook per monument unless placed in monument base, when two shepherd's hooks will be allowed.
- Shepherd's hooks need to be against the monument base and turned to the gravesite.
- Winter grave blankets are allowed October 15-March 15.
- Clean-off dates begin March 15 and October 15.
- Prohibited grave decorations include:
 - Outlining grave or monument with any material
 - oGlass or ceramic vessels
 - OBenches at gravesite
