Codes, officer in place, officials look at new properties to raze

Hoopeston officials have identified three blighted properties for demolition and at Tuesday's city council meeting, added two more that could come down by year's end.

A house at 210 E. Washington, owned by the late Brian Suiter, and the Dyer mansion at 520 E. Honeywell, with Erik and Tina Pelikant listed as the owners, could be demolished by the end of the year, said Mike Davis, director of Central Illinois Land Bank, at the meeting.

Mr. Suiter died last year of injuries he received when another building he owned, the former Hoopeston Plumbing and Heating building at 219 S. Market, collapsed while he was working inside of it. Mayor Bill Crusinberry said several attempts to reach Suiter's heirs have gone without response.

The Pelikants had worked on the Dyer mansion in hopes of living there, but a 2015 fire caused significant damage. While the family did not live there, squatters have been reported staving in what was once one of Hoopeston's grandest homes.

Davis said that with the International Property Maintenance Code in place, along with an intergovernmental agreement between Hoopeston and the land bank, and code enforcement officer Dave Biggerstaff hired, the land bank can now begin action to take control of both.

Basing his timeline on it taking abandonment legalities to take six months. Davis said the land bank could have

title to the properties by October. If that happens, "my thought is let's get this done yesterday," he said, adding he would immediately issue requests for proposals and demolition could be done in November or December.

The abandonment program approved by the council on Tuesday lists criteria for abandonment as either the property taxes or water bills have been delinquent for two or more years, the property is not occupied by those legally in possession and the building is unsafe or dangerous for reasons listed in the petition for abandonment. If those criteria are met, photos of the property will be taken and information presented at a court hearing.
