Newly-elected officials were sworn in and those leaving were recognized at Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting.

Ward 3 incumbents Lourdine Florek and Joe Garret and newcomers Kyle Richards in Ward 1; Kellie Ferrell, Ward 2; and Bob Porth in Ward 4, were sworn in by Clerk Gail Lane at the start of the meeting. Stephen Evrich was appointed to fill a Ward 1 vacancy and was sworn in separately.

Lane, Mayor Bill Crusinberry and Treasurer Edye Bookwalter also took their oaths Tuesday.

After the council was seated, Crusinberry presented gifts to departing aldermen Carl Ankenbrand, who served on the council for 18 years, and Bill Goodwine, with 29 years.

Bill McElhaney, who lost his Ward 1 seat, did not at-

tend to receive his gift.

In other business, the council approved the wage ordinance, which specifies pay rates and ranges for categories of employees. Crusinberry said that while an ordinance is approved annually, there is usually not much change. However, with increases in the minimum wage and annual employee raises, some workers were getting near the top of the previous ranges.

The vote on the ordinance was 7-0 with Lawson absent. Florek announced that Kristi Hudson has been named swimming pool manager for the upcoming season. She also briefly reported on a national chlorine shortage that has increased the price of the disinfectant. Hoopeston's supply should be adequate, she said.

Wise reported that the street/alley department is purchasing an International dump truck for \$117,078. Alley cleanup has ended and the department will start taking down more trees.

Crusinberry, along with Central Illinois Land Bank officials and Bill Nicholls, Hoopeston's representative to the land bank, toured Hoopeston to look at vacant and dilapidated properties. The land bank has possession of four properties and two more have been put on the list: the fire-damaged mansion at 520 E. Honeywell and a house at 210 E. Washington.
