Partners expand insurance holdings, keep local office open despite trying business times

Expanding a business in the midst of a pandemic might not seem like the best decision to a lot of people.

But for Jeremy Deck and business partner Cathy Luecke, the decision is paying off.

Deck and Luecke co-own 4 Corners Insurance Agency in Rankin, started after the pair purchased the former Taylor-Higgins-Ellis Agency in 2017.

In October 2020, they purchased the former Polson Agency, merging it into 4 Corners, and now have six months under their belt running both offices.

For Deck, a former Hoopeston resident who now lives in rural Rossville, purchasing the Hoopeston office was the fulfillment of an idea that occurred eight years earlier.

In 2012, Deck was traveling Illinois working for TOIRMA - Township Officials of Illinois Risk Management Association - which offers various insurance products to Illinois townships. Wanting to get back to the independent insurance side, he sent letters to two local agencies, saying if the owners ever decided to sell or decided to retire, he was interested in buying. Neither owner responded, and Deck went on to work in other agencies and open his own real estate business, as well.

It was not until August 2020 that Deck received a reply to one of the letters he sent those years ago. Anne "Chris" Polson, widow of Leon Polson, founder of Polson Insurance, contacted Deck, saying she and Karen Polson found Deck's letters going through agency paperwork.

Deck and Mrs. Polson talked for a while. "(It) felt like Polson Insurance and 4 Corners would be a good fit," Deck said, adding the agency was "a small town independent agency who cares about their clients." He and Luecke purchased the agency on October 1, 2020.

Deck and Luecke opted to leave the agency in its existing location, 218 E. Main, renting the building from the Polson family.

The purchase set off a flurry of activity, as the new agency owners set about cleaning, painting and rearranging things.

As the Polson Agency, Leon Polson took the back part of the building for his agency and his first wife, Pat, operated a travel office from the front. When she died, Mr. Polson kept his office where it had been.

When he passed, Karen Polson Eighner, his niece, was in the process of updating the look of the interior

when she and Chris Polson decided to sell the business.

Luecke and Deck moved the work area to the forefront, taking advantage of the natural light streaming in the large windows and allowing customers to be greeted immediately on entering.
