Rankin man saves cab in fire

CHAMPAIGN—A Rankin man saved his semi cab but the trailer he was hauling went up in flames Sunday.

Loren B. Spengler, 61, was eastbound on Interstate 74 near mile post 190 when a fire began in the brakes of the semi trailer, according to Illinois State Police. Spengler pulled his vehicle to the site of the interstate. After stopping, the fire spread to the loaded trailer.

Spengler then separated the tractor from the trailer, moving the truck tractor forward about 20 yards. The trailer quickly became engulfed and the load burned for approximately 40 minutes, police said.

Both lanes of Interstate 74 were closed to traffic for about two hours.

No injuries were reported.
